Here is the detailed timetable showing all the exams being taken at College this summer. You should study this carefully.

It is the time given on this timetable that you must follow.

Where it says "**Assemble Time**" this means the time you must be waiting outside the exam room. It will then give you enough time to file into the exam room and papers to be issued in a calm and organised manner with the aim of starting approximately 5-10 minutes later. Remember, **exam conditions start immediately you enter the exam room** – if you can't remember these please refer to the Exam Guide given to you earlier this year or go onto the College Website: www.robertsbridge.org.uk or VLE where you will find a copy on the Exam Page.

Please note that lessons will be running for each subject until the date of that subject examination (or the last unit for that subject). Rooms will be allocated for revision sessions. These will be properly supervised rooms and only for students who want to study. You must always take your own revision material.

NB You should only attend College to sit an exam or to attend a revision class. **THEREFORE you MUST NOT** wander the College disturbing other students, sunbathe on the field, play football etc.

If you have a 'clash' of exams (one or more exams scheduled at the same time on the day) please see Mrs Marden as soon as possible.

REMEMBER:

- Arrive on the correct day, at the right time and on time.
- **You must wear your school uniform.**
- **Phone the College immediately** if you have a problem and you are going to be late or if you are ill **(01580 880360) ext 115**
- **Sign in** – there will be clipboards for each registration group at reception. (Remember to **sign out** when you leave.)
- **No** bags, coats, books etc in the exam room.
- **NO MOBILES , iPods or MP3 players in the exam room.** You will be disqualified from the exam if one is found on you in the room once the exam has started.
- **Bring all the equipment you need for each exam** (see-through pencil cases only or a clear plastic bag).
- **You must use black ink.**
- **No calculator lids are allowed in the room.**
- You may bring a small bottle of water and packet of mints (without labels on).

You will receive a personal Statement of Entry in due course showing the rooms and seat numbers allocated to you for each of your exams.
