January Examination Timetable 2010

This timetable relates to ALL exams being taken in January 2010. You will NOT be taking ALL of these exams. You will need to check which ones you are taking from your Statement of Entry - and highlight them for your information.

Most Science exams have two sittings. You must check the Exam Notice Board to see which sitting you have been allocated.

Where it says “**Assemble Time**” on your timetable - this means the time you should be waiting outside the exam room or supervision rooms.

If you have been allocated to a **supervision room**:-

- You must go to the supervision room at the Assemble time where you will be supervised by a teacher until it is time to take your exam.
- **You must NOT leave the supervision room. If you do, you will be disqualified from the exam.**
- You must take to the room only the equipment needed for the exam.
- Bags must be left in lockers.
- Mobile phones are NOT allowed in the supervision room.
- You may revise for the exam while you are waiting – revision guides will be provided.
- You will be escorted to the exam room.

Remember, **exam conditions start immediately you enter the exam room.**

You should leave your personal belongings in your locker. If you do not have a locker please speak to Mrs Marden before the day of the exam.

IMPORTANT – you **MUST** check the Exam Notice Board everyday to check the Seating Plans. (Exam Notice Board is outside the Staffroom).

IF YOU ARE NOT TAKING AN EXAM YOU SHOULD GO TO YOUR NORMAL LESSONS

Try to remember your seat number for each exam as this will speed up the process of getting you settled into the exam room.

Absence from the exam:

- Make sure you attend all the exams you have been entered for.
- If you are ill on the day of the exam please phone the college first thing in the morning. Application for Special Consideration can be submitted but you must provide a supporting note from your doctor.

A Reminder of the Examination Rules

You should be familiar with the **JCQ Notice to Candidates**. (You have already been given a copy of this. There is also one displayed on the Exam Notice Board.)

Main points to remember:

- **Do NOT talk, communicate or disturb anyone else in the exam room**
- **You are NOT allowed to take a mobile phone into the exam room – even if it is switched off.**
- **Pencil cases are NOT allowed in the exam room unless they are see-through. A see-through plastic bag is allowed.**
- **Calculator lids are NOT allowed in the exam room.**
- **You must write in BLACK ink or ballpoint pen.**
- **Bags, books notes or valuables are NOT allowed in the exam room. You must leave any of these items in your locker before you assemble for the exam.**

You are allowed to take a small bottle of water (without a label) and one small packet of mints (without the wrapper) into the exam room.

Basic equipment you should take into the exam: two black pens, a pencil, ruler, rubber and pencil sharpener. Some exams will require a Calculator – if you are not sure then check with your teacher.
